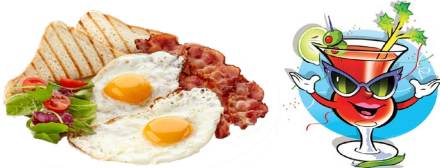

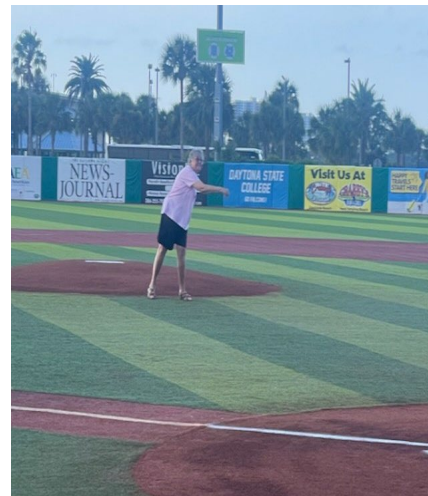
REMINDER/St Simon's Island Trip
